Letter of Credence

To All Nations and Their Sovereign Governments,

I, Mana Ali'i Nui Aleka Aipoalani, by the Grace of I'o (God) and by the Will of our People, Sovereign Authority of The Polynesian Kingdom of Atooi / Hawaiian Kingdom, Sovereign of the Polynesian Triangle and Protector of the Seas, send greetings and assurances of our highest esteem.

In the spirit of peace, friendship, diplomacy, and the enduring principles of international comity, We have deemed it proper to dispatch to Your Excellencies **Customary Chief Ali'i Mathew Kalaniwaikēolani Verdugo**, who shall act in the capacity of Chargé D' Affaires ad hoc, invested with plenipotentiary authority to represent Our Kingdom in a single and defined mission pertaining to the advancement of mutual recognition and peaceful relations among nations.

I, therefore, commend Our Envoy to Your Excellencies' gracious consideration, requesting that you receive him with the trust and confidence that We Ourselves would command, and grant full faith to all acts performed by him in the execution of this sacred duty, as if done by My Own Hand.

May this mission strengthen the bonds of friendship, affirm the dignity of all nations, and contribute to the harmony of humankind under the guidance of divine providence.

Given under Our Hand and Seal at Our Royal Seat in Honolulu, this 25th of October, in the Year of Our Lord 2025.

Subject: **Transmission of Foundational Documents of the Polynesian Kingdom of Atooi / Hawaiian Kingdom**

Your Excellency,

On behalf of His Majesty Mana Ali'i Nui Aleka Aipoalani, Supreme Sovereign Authority of the Polynesian Kingdom of Atooi / Hawaiian Kingdom, I have the honor to transmit herewith an official packet of documents constituting the lawful and constitutional framework of the Kingdom.

This compilation reaffirms the continuity of the Hawaiian Kingdom as a sovereign and independent State under international law and provides the updated instruments by which His Majesty exercises authority in accordance with customary law, treaty law, and constitutional law.

The enclosed documents include:

1. **Hawaiian Kingdom Constitution 1839/1840, 1852, and 2019**, establishing the constitutional monarchy, prerogatives of His Majesty, the Privy Council, the Central Bank of Atooi, and governance structure.
2. **Synopsis of the Sovereign (2025)** – enumerating the inalienable rights of His Majesty as Sovereign.
3. **Synopsis of Rights Inherent in the Polynesian Kingdom of Atooi / Hawaiian Kingdom (2019)** – prepared by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
4. **Synopsis of the Sovereign (1856)** – enumerating the inalienable rights of His Majesty as Sovereign by R.C. Wyllie.
5. **Royal Decree: King Kamehameha III 1856 (2019, reaffirmed)** – affirming His Majesty's succession, constitutional prerogatives, and royal authority (archival decree).

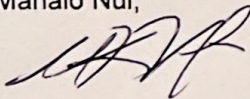
6. **Royal Decree on Peace, Friendship, and Diplomacy (2025)** – reaffirming the Maupiti Treaty (1817–1823) and establishing modern diplomatic commitments across Te Moana Nui A Kiva.
7. **Royal Decree on Peace, Friendship, and Diplomacy (2025)**, French Polynesian Acknowledgement with seals.
8. **Color of Law, Declaration of Authority & Doctrinal Annex**– affirming doctrines of continuity, including Postliminium, Stimson Doctrine, Trusteeship Law, and UN Charter Articles 73–85.
9. **Royal Treasury Decree (2025)** – reconstituting the Treasury and financial sovereignty, including issuance of Kala digital currency, bonds, and certificates.
10. **Lawful Notice Regarding the Hawaiian Kingdom Treasury (Re-Opening of the Hawaiian Treasury)** – affirming historic financial sovereignty and recovery of assets.
11. **Royal Declaration Regarding the Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) and Occupying Agencies** – clarifying OHA’s status as a U.S./State agency, reaffirming Statute Laws of Kamehameha III, and placing foreign and state actors on notice.

Collectively, these instruments affirm that the Polynesian Kingdom of Atooi / Hawaiian Kingdom stands today as a **de jure sovereign government**, entitled to the full rights, privileges, and protections accorded to Nation States under international law.

We respectfully request that these documents be entered into the official record of your esteemed institution and acknowledged in all future correspondence and proceedings.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
