# Childcare funding and fees

We are open Monday to Wednesday from 8am until 5:30pm.

We will be closed for one week over the Easter period

We will be closed for one week for May half term

We will close for three weeks in the school summer holidays

We will close for one week in October or November (half term)

We will close for two weeks for the school Christmas holiday

Hourly fee - £8

Note- contracted hours are reserved for the child and must be paid in full regardless of attendance. See Fees Policy for full information.

You will be sent an invoice towards the end of the month for the following month's payment, this will need to be paid by or on the 1st day of the month. Preferred payment is by bank transfer.

Sickness- If I am unwell then you will not be charged for the time that I am closed. If your child is unwell then you will still be charged.

Holidays- If I take a holiday then no fee will be charged as the setting will be closed. If you should take any holiday during our open hours then the full amount must still be paid. This also applies if you take your child out for a single day.

- Sun hat and Sun cream
- Appropriate footwear i.e Wellington boots if raining
- Hats, gloves and scarves for colder weather
- Baby formula/breast milk and bottles
- Packed lunch (with additional snacks if you wish)
- Comfort toys/blankets/dummy
- Medication if required
- Coat/rain mac appropriate for the weather
- Anything else you think your child may require.
