This USB stick contains 20 fine performances for your BK7m with four extra new groups of sounds which you can select with the **ONE TOUCH SETTING BUTTONS. (OTS)**To compliment these fine registrations there is of course a suitable rhythm style and backing for each . Not only have we created new one touch sounds through the performance editing process but new reverb and other effects have been utilised to bring new life into these fine BK instruments , all within this simple plug-and-play USB. As a bonus there is also a folder with extra user styles but not all of these have one touch sounds but you can make your own by following your user manual for "one touch edit"

## To load the USB please follow these Steps:

- 1. Insert the USB in your BK-7M and press the performance list button. (The screen should now display the performance list.
- 2. Rotate the silver wheel clockwise until "Legends" is Highlighted then press the wheel to select. (screen should now display a list of the 20 numbered and named performances available)
- 3. Rotate the wheel to select which performance you want and press the wheel to select.
- 4. Press the "one touch" button so it is lit (the performance and sounds are now loaded and ready to use, there are five to choose from by means of an initial set plus four more with the four one touch buttons)
- 5. You can use the "exit" but to escape at any time should you make a mistake and follow these steps again.
- 6. We advise that you make a backup copy of this software on your computer.

Please note that the sounds and left hand accompaniments have been set for those who play full left hand chords. If you wish to change the left hand mode to [ SINGLE FINGER CHORD ] please refer to your User manual.
