

<u>COVID Precautions Update</u>: As of August 1, the infection rate in Erie County is increasing and many anticipate a mask mandate for indoor gatherings will happen soon. As a precaution, the Church Board will require everyone in worship to wear a mask <u>while not seated</u> beginning August 8. Additional hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building, and we will discourage shaking or holding hands during worship. As things change in our area, adjustments will be made accordingly. Please get vaccinated for your sake and for ours.

<u>God's Work Our Hands Sunday</u> returns on September 12. This is an annual day of service in which many ELCA congregations participate. We begin the day with a brief worship service followed by participation in a variety of activities for all ages at Lord of Life and in the community.
