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

Neil Badham (Ensemble)

Neil is a longtime resident of Palm Springs, originally from Worcestershire, England. He is excited to be in another performance at the Palm Canyon Theatre. His first was Sunset Boulevard, followed by 9–5, Titanic, Palm Springs Getaway, She Loves Me, Brigadoon, Elf, and Something Rotten!

Linda Mack Berven (Beggar Woman)

She has sung with the Robert Shaw Festival Singers, Santa Fe Pro Musica, Victoria Bach Festival, and many local and regional ensembles, and has conducted the Santa Fe Desert Chorale, the Durango Choral Society at Carnegie Hall, and in Prague, Greece, Zagreb, and Salzburg. Linda is a member of Merely Players Theatre Company and Durango Arts Repertory Theatre. Her acting credits include *Bye Bye Birdie* (Mae Peterson), *Fiddler on the Roof* (Fruma-Sarah), *The Mikado* (Katisha), *L'Histoire du Soldat* (the Devil) and *The Odd Couple* (Gwendolyn).

David Brooks (Fogg/Ensemble)
