A NOTE FROM THE CO-ARTISTIC DIRECTOR:

What do I aim for when choosing a season?

My aim is to celebrate life's joys without shying away from life's tragedies. In theatre, we bear witness to intense experiences without risk to ourselves, and we are made better for it. We may laugh, we may cry, but in either case, we look to theatre to inspire and invigorate us, to make us more fully alive, more in harmony with our fellow human beings. Conflict and passion are the stuff of theatre, and in planning our 29th season, I wanted it to reflect harmony, love, and conflict. I have been struck by how these seeming opposites are intimately linked: Three friends brayely venturing across enemy lines to find harmony, and their escapades on the way, in Priscilla Queen of the Desert. To an orphan bereft of parental love, the world must seem a lonely battleground in the beloved musical ANNIE. Navigating the challenges and joys of life spent together in IDO! IDO!. Hair embraces love of life so passionately it protests the looming horrors of war. Life has paralyzed Norma Desmond to the point that she delusionally hangs onto her past in Sunset Boulevard. Bearing the ills of the foreign military world, Molina drowns his soul in the memoirs of The Kiss of the Spiderwoman. The protagonist, in The Ritz, unknowingly finds refuge in, to him, a battleground, and the comedic tactics he uses to navigate his situations. The Wizard of OZ, making us realize the qualities we seek are often within us already, and the power of friendship has much more weight than we think or acknowledge. To celebrate life's joys in harmony with others. This PCT season, as always, I hope that it will prove reflective, passionate, and inspiring for you!
