

## Free Card Class Printable

# 5x7 and Mini Slimline Greeting Cards with a mini album or junk journal twist

Please visit my YouTube Channel for the full length video tutorial. I shared three different cutting dimensions and lots of tips and tricks for making these cards. This class and printable are completely free. I just ask that you subscribe to my channel, which is also free.

### **Cutting instructions**

#### Card #1

The first card example shared in the video is for a 5 x 7 card and yields the most scraps from your 12 X 12 paper. Please note that you can also use 8.5 X 11 paper for this design if you like. You need to choose 3 sheets of paper for each card you want to make. The cover will always be cut to the size of finished card desired. The two inside pages will be cut smaller.

Cut cover to 7"x 10". Cut the 7 inch side first and be mindful of your directional paper. Next, cut the 10" side and score at five.

Cut your two inside pages to 6 3/4" x 9.5" fold in half on the the 9.5 inch side. Next, you can punch out thumbholes for each side pocket on the front and back cover. Please cut the 6  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch side first for the best A2 scraps.

Follow the video for all of the other assembly, decorations, and filler ideas.

#### Card #2

This card is also a 5x7, but you will cut the two inside pages differently than the first example. This variation gives you built-in pockets and fewer scraps. There is a bit more scoring and trimming, but it is not difficult.

Cut cover to 7"x 10". Cut the 7 inch side first and be mindful of your directional paper. Next, cut the 10" side and score at five.

Cut inside pages to 9" x 9 3/4" Cut the width at 9 inches first for the best scraps. Then cut to 9  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch. Score at 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch on the 9 inch side, and score 3 inches up from the bottom on the 9  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch side. Once you have scored both sides then you can cut a v shape for your pockets. Punch thumb holes for the front and back cover pages.

#### Card #3

This is the mini slimline edition which is great for using up all of those 6x6 paper pads. You still just need three sheets of paper for the card. A cover sheet and two inside pages. You may also want to use cut-a-parts, ephemera, or more paper to finish the cards off.

Cover use 1 6x6 sheet of paper scored or folded vertically at 3 inches.

Inside pages can be  $5.5 \times 5.5$  inches or slightly larger if you like. Score or fold vertically down the middle. Punch thumb holes for the front and back cover pages.
