The 3 Ds Checklist

To ensure your property is captured in the best possible light, it's important to prepare it thoroughly before the photography session. Follow this checklist based on the "3 Ds": Declutter, Deep Clean, and Depersonalize.



>>> <u>D</u>eclutter

Living Areas:

• Clear surfaces and remove excess furniture.

Kitchen:

Clear countertops; hide appliances and fridge magnets.

Bathrooms:

• Store personal items and tidy surfaces.

Bedrooms:

• Make beds; clear nightstands and closets.

Outdoor Areas:

• Store away tools, toys, and seasonal decor.

Deep Clean <<<

General:

• Dust all surfaces; vacuum and mop floors; clean all windows.

Kitchen:

Clean appliances and wipe down surfaces.

Bathrooms:

• Scrub tiles, polish fixtures, and clean mirrors.

Outdoor Areas:

• Sweep walkways; clean windows and doors.





>>> Depersonalize

Living Areas:

• Remove family photos and personal items.

Bedrooms

• Use neutral linens; remove personal decor.

General:

• Minimize bold decor; use neutral colors.

FINAL TOUCHES

- Ensure all light bulbs are working and of the same temperature (e.g., all warm or all cool).
- Open blinds and curtains to maximize natural light.
- Adjust the thermostat to a comfortable temperature before the shoot.
