

Scent & Social Bonding in Multi-Cat Homes

- Synthetic feline pheromones help soften the emotional tone of the home.
- They don’t create friendship, but they reduce baseline tension.
- Pheromones work best as one supportive layer in a larger harmony plan.

Reducing Tension Through Predictability

- Cats bond best when their environment feels safe and consistent.
- Steady routines and multiple resting zones help maintain a stable shared scent profile.
- When cats aren’t startled or pressured, their bodies stay relaxed enough to form positive associations.

Maintaining Scent After Stressful Events

- Vet visits, grooming, or loud disruptions can temporarily alter a cat’s scent and increase tension.
- Offering quiet decompression time helps each cat settle back into their baseline scent.
- Gentle reintroduction after stressful events prevents sudden spikes in conflict.

Building Shared Scent Through Calm Coexistence

- Cats strengthen social bonds simply by resting or exploring in the same room without pressure.
- Parallel play and parallel enrichment help create positive shared scent experiences.
- Calm coexistence builds familiarity that feels safe, predictable, and emotionally steady.
