

* 1744 Oedelsheim, missing, wounded, died pres. 1779

Conrad Gerland, Private, Rgmt. v. Bose

* 1748 Gottsbüren, missing, POW, ransomed, returned home 1781
His three grandsons emigrated to the U.S. ("Maryland Gerlands")

Gerhard Gerland, Private, Rgmt. v. Lengerke

* 1748 Gieselwerder, wounded, returned home

1st Gerland Branch in the USA: OHIO I (since 1839)

- Heinrich Christian Gerland, *1789 in Gieselwerder, was farm hand who moved to the rural village Venne, Lower Saxony for a better life
- He married in Venne and had 5 children
- Venne was such a poor village that, between 1830 and 1880, 1,722 inhabitants emigrated to the USA. Slogan:

"Here we are only slaves of the farmers There we drive in golden coaches"

- Frederick Gerland 08Jul1824 Ohio I Branch
- Origin Gieselwerder

Day Laborer Cincinnati, OH.

- Among them were all 5 Gerland children: 4 Gerland brothers Frederick, Henry, William & Hermann emigrated to Cincinnati, OH. in 1839 & 1852, and sister Wilhelmine & husband went to Indiana
- > They worked as foundryman, moulder & cigarmaker
- > They owned homes on Front Street & Emming Street
- Frederick & Henry were Civil War Veterans (Privates betw. 1861 & 1865 in the Union Army, 70th Regiment, Ohio Infantry, Company I). Fred was POW of Confederates

2nd Gerland Branch in the USA: OHIO III (since 1847)

Henry Gerland,*1824, was a farmer in Heisebeck, Kassel County

- > 7th of 8 children
- > Year of immigration unkown, before 1847
- According to US Census 1870, he married Katherine, 16 years his senior, 1847 in Colerain Township, OH. (Cincinnati area)
- > 1 son John Henry found in the Document Center of Colerain Township (www.colerain.org)
- Henry's sister Charlotte Gerland-Wenzel lived in Linwood, Cincinnati, OH.

No information found so far about living descendants

- William Gerland *1837 came to America in 1856
- > 1st wife: Therese Auer, 1 child
- > 2nd wife: Mary Bossert, 3 children
- Therese died 09Jan1883 (age 43) and William married Mary (age 22) only six weeks later
- ➢ In US Census 1880, William & Therese are listed as next door neighbors of Mary's family
- William's younger sisters Charlotte & Wilhelmine also emigrated to the US



Sumner, Ia. — Henry Conrad Garland, '98, Sumner's oldest citizen, died Friday at his home here of a complication of age. He had been a carpenter and cabinet mak-

Mr. Garland was born Jan. 27, 1847, at Ludersfeld, Shamburg Lippe, Germany, was baptized in infancy and was confirmed Apr. 7, 1861.

He married Anna Meier in May, 1869, in Germany. They came to the United States in 1871, and lived first at Crane Creek, now Readlyn, Ia., until the summer of 1874, when they came to Sumner.

Mr. Garland was the last charter member of St. John's Lutheran church.

Surviving are six children, Mrs. Anna Wilharm, Mrs. Sophia Wolff, Herman and George, Sumner; Will and Emil, Sacramento, Cal.; 20 grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren and four great great grandchildren: wife and two sons, Hen-

ry and Otto, preceded him.

Ludwig Karl (Louis Carl) Gerland, *15Sep1858 Gottsbüren

- Great-grandson of Conrad Gerland, Hessian Mercenary in the Revolutionary War
- Came to Maryland in 1882 on steamship "Hermann"
- Owned a grocery store in Shipley, MD., 7 children
- > 3 Siblings also emigrated to Maryland
- "Gerland Street" in Baltimore"
- Grandson Bill Gerland was policeman, security officer at the White House



Conrad & Heinrich (Henry) Friedrich Gerland, born in Hülshagen, were brothers

- > 3rd cousins of IOWA Gerlands
- Conrad Gerland came to America 1887 when he was only 14.
 He started a creamery in Rice Lake, WI., 9 children
- > Conrad's grandchildren started the Gerland Reunions 1992 in Rice Lake, WI.
- Henry Gerland came to America in 1900. He married Rosa Schäfer whose father was eye-witness of the Sioux raid on New Ulm, MN. in 1862
- > Henry Gerland owned a creamery in Sleepy Eye, MN., 4 children

- Henry was born 23Sep1884 in Hannover-Linden
- > came to America in 1905, pres. escaping military service
- In the U.S. he called himself "Captain Henry"
- > Pres. of General Stevedore & Ballast Co., San Francisco
- > was married three times:
- > 1. Ida, ∞ 1905, divorced for "cruelty"
- ➤ 2. Ernestine, ∞ 1914, divorced for "improper conduct"
 ("drank to excess", "alienated by a wealthy and comely
 widow who came into a large heritage")
- > 3. Julia, ∞ in 1950s, 30 years younger, his housekeeper
- > Two sons with Ida:
- > Henry W. Gerland, *1906, grandfather of Judi & Bonnie
- > John Gerland, *1912, † 1939 at car accident

Information about Gottsbüren

- First mentioned in the year 822
- Nearby was a monastry, in desperate need of money
- In 1330, they launched the "Miracle of Gottsbüren": The body of Jesus Christ was found in the forest surrounding the village
- For abt. 70 years, the village became a place of pilgrimage with huge proceeds from pilgrims from all over Europe
- In 1330/1331, the church of pilgrimage was built
- In 1334, Sababurg Castle was built for protection (later chosen by the Grimm Brothers as "Sleeping Beauty's Castle")
- ❖ Population today: 700+

First Gerland in Gottsbüren: Frantz Gerland

- * Born abt 1620 in Schaumburg County
- ❖ Settled in Gottsbüren betw.1635-1640
- In the middle of the 30 Years' War 1618 1648
- Catholic troops devastated and plundered Gottsbüren in 1623

Frantz Gerland, Blacksmith

- Came to Gottsbüren as a blacksmith
- Had a blacksmith shop at the outskirts of the village
- * 3 children: Sabrina, Georg & Ricus
- Frantz Gerland is the ancestor of 322 "Gerland" births in Gottsbüren until 1925, incl. all US-Gerlands who immigrated from Gottsbüren
- He is also my ancestor

- 5. Conrad *1748 (Hessian mercenary in the Revolutionary War, 1 of 40 from Gottsbüren) All of Conrad's grandchildren emigrated to the U.S. > Maryland Gerlands
- 6. Maria Elisabeth *1750
- 7. Anna Elisabeth *1751, married Niemeyer
- 8. Georg *1753 died as infant
- 9. Johann Philipp *1756, master potter



- > They had 11 children, 8 died as infants
- 1. Justus Henrich *1786 pres. died as infant
- 2. Johann Frantz Ludwig *1788 pres. died as infant
- 3. Maria Wilhelmine *1791 married Johann Wilhelm Nolte one premarital daughter
- 4. Anna Maria *14Dec1794 married 1824 Conrad Niemeyer four children, 1st son Burghard Friedrich *1819 outside marriage, descendants Manfred, Norbert & Lutz Gerland, Helga Davin
- 5. Henrich Justus *1797 died 1801
- 6. Louise *1799 died 1800
- 7. Maria *1801 died 1805

In the 18th and early 19th century, the infant mortality rate was abt. 50%. Major reasons: Diarrhea (the squirts) and smallpox

Carl Ludwig Gerland * 05Aug1807 Gottsbüren Nr. 95

- Father of John Henry > Ohio II Gerlands
- > Was day laborer
- Married to Marie Wilhelmine Morgenstern *18Dec1807
- > They had 6 children, 3 sons, 3 daughters, first 3 died as infants




