

VISIT ISLAND PARK

Big Springs & Jonny Sack's Cabin Walk the path to the historical J.S. cabin, Feed the fish from the bridge, possibility of wildlife sighting, and is a great location for photos.

Mesa Falls - Upper & Lower hiking trails to observe Mesa Falls

Sawtelle Peak (Elevation 9866 ft) Drive to the top of Sawtelle Peak and take in the panoramic views of Island Park.

Harriman State Park (11,000 acres) - 22 miles of hiking, biking, and horseback trails along the meadows and riverbanks. Some of the best Fly Fishing.

Eagle Ridge Ranch (140 acres) - Book your adventure - Fishing, horseback riding, archery, and skeetshooting.

Mack's Inn River Adventures - Book your float down the North Fork of the Snake River. An easy 5 mile float with opportunity of seeing wildlife.

Island Park Golf Course - A 9 hole golf course with a par 3 - 5

Water Sports Rentals (Lakeside Lodge) - Rent a Pontoon, fishing boat, Jet ski, kayaks, and paddleboards, and enjoy the Island Park Reservoir.

Box Canyon Floating - Float the Box to Last Chance. Approximately 4 miles. Class II

Targhee Pass (Elevation 7,072) - Targhee Pass is on the Continental Divide at the Idaho / Montana border heading to Yellowstone National Park.

Yellowstone Playhouse Island Park, ID - Book an evening of fun with dinner, and a show.

Wade & Cliff Lakes Canoe or paddleboard on beautiful emerald lakes. Pack a picnic and enjoy a day of fun and relaxation.

Quake Lake (6 miles long, and 125 feet deep) Drive around Quake Lake and stop by the visitor center. In 1959 an earthquake struck on Aug 17th creating Quake Lake.

Grizzly Wolf Discover Center (Open 365 days a year) - See bears, wolves, and otters as well as other exhibits.

IMAX (60' x 80' screen) - Yellowstone in IMAX, and various other new releases.
