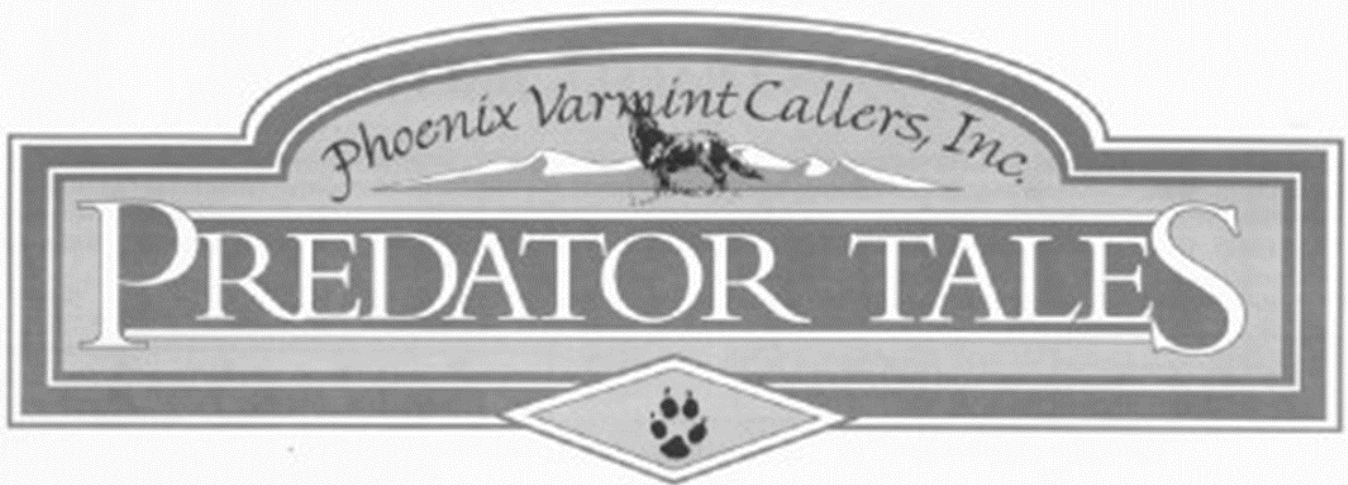

MEMBER REVIEW— Work Sharp Knife and Tool Sharpener—by Wayne W

One of the small pleasures in my life has been my ongoing and life-long relationship with my pocket knife. Whether I gained the love from my father or my grandfather I don't rightly know, but some of my oldest memories are of my granddad whipping out the Old Timer and fixing the problem at hand. It didn't matter if he was carving up a deer, slicing an apple, or



giving a little self-manicure after working on a greasy engine, Granddad always had a sharp knife in his pocket. Somewhere along the lines I picked up the habit and have carried one most of my life. The problem was, and still is . . . I'm extremely hard on my blades. I can take a ridiculously sharp blade, and scrape, cut and chop it down to where it's dangerously dull and isn't good for much more than spreading butter.

This is where the WorkSharp Knife and Tool Sharpener comes

in. I had wanted one of these for quite a while but was having a hard time justifying the \$79.99 price tag. It was only through the subliminal promptings to my children and wife "This is what I want for Fathers Day and it's \$30 off right now" that I was finally able to march down to my local Sportsman's Warehouse, gift card in hand, and pick one up.

Now I have it on good word that Crocodile Dundee uses one of these prior to "Going Walkabout", and with good reason. This little gem has a two-speed motor and two pre-set angles that allow me with 3 or 4 stokes of the blade, to bring my knives back to Rambo Sharp in a matter of seconds. With interchangeable flexible abrasive belts, you can take just about any knife and correct and polish the blade angle in a matter of seconds, if not minutes. Prices at the time of this writing are \$79.99 for the sharpener (Amazon) and approx \$18.99 for a 24-pack of belts (80/120/240/400/1000/1200 grits) However once the angle is set, I rarely need to change away from the 1200 grit. One word of caution when using this sharpener - Your friends will wonder what happened to all the hair on your arms! 🐾


