MISSION

1Voice envisions creating a space that provides a safe and supportive environment for the recovery community, their family members, and those contemplating taking the first steps towards their own personal path to recovery.

We at 1Voice hope that soon with the support of community partners like yourself, we can open our community's first Peer Recovery Center.

The 1Voice Recovery Center will be a safe and supportive place to discover community resources, engage in pro-social activities and recovery related programs, and immediately connect with a Peer Recovery Coach.

The recovery center would host a wide variety of services, such as one-on-one & group peer support, a resource center, recreational activities, a multi-media center, & more.

Our goal is to create a space where peers can thrive through connection, growth, and on-going support.

We plan to accomplish this by offering various activities and recreational areas for peers to participate in as they discover more about themselves on their personal recovery journey.

The 1Voice Recovery Center will host the following activity areas.

1. Resource Lab
2. Multi-Media Center
3. Arts/Crafts
4. Music Area
5. Self Help Library
6. Game/Activity Area

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Individualized Peer Support

Our peer to peer services involve recovery management, goal setting, recovery resource navigating, and sharing lived experience from both the peer and participant.

Community Outreach

Collaborating with community partners is the heartbeat of what we do. We as peer supports understand that we can't help everyone, and are able to provide community resources and link peers to local treatment providers.

Peer Facilitated Support Groups

We currently offer a variety of online and in person mutual support meetings.

At 1Voice we support all pathways to recovery.

Recreational Activities

We will provide areas for peers to engage in various activities daily, while also hosting monthly organized events such as game nights, art classes, and open mic nights.

Media Center

We will provide areas for peers to utilize technology in advancing and strengthening their personal recovery through apps, inspirational content, wellness related programming, education software and online trainings.

Narcan Training

Through our partnership with Overdose lifeline we are able to provide information, immediate access to Narcan, and training on its use.

Free Boutique

Come check out our Free Boutique for new and lightly used household items, hygiene products, and clothing. We are always accepting donations.

1Voice Recovery Center Policy & Procedures

1. The 1Voice Recovery Center will operate under an inclusive policy and is open to anyone in the community willing to help maintain the safe and supportive environment of everyone involved.
2. All local, state, and federal laws and guidelines will be followed.
3. This must remain a substance free environment.
4. There is a no tolerance policy for any acts of violence.
5. Everyone that enters will be required to sign in and sign out on the daily activity log.
6. There will be no smoking, vaping, or tobacco use inside the building.
7. All incidents, damages, and or any altercations will be documented by staff and may result in temporary or permanent loss of access to the 1Voice Recovery Center.
8. Everyone is required to clean up activity areas after their use.
9. During mutual support meetings the activity areas upstairs will be closed.
10. Keeping the 1Voice Recovery Center a safe place is our utmost importance, please respect others anonymity and confidentiality at all times.
11. 1Voice and our community partners are not responsible for any loss or damages to guest's personal property, or injury occurred while at the recovery center.

STAFF PROCEDURES

1. Staff must complete opening and closing checklist every day upon arrival and exiting the building.
2. Staff will treat everyone with respect and without bias.
3. Staff will enforce 1Voice Recovery Center policies to maintain a safe and supportive environment at all times.
4. In case of inclement weather staff on duty will be required to complete snow/ice removal and maintain safe conditions entering and exiting building.
5. All incidents must be documented the day of occurrence.
6. All crimes committed on building premises must be reported to local authorities.
7. In case of any medical emergency immediately call 911 followed by call to designated 1Voice emergency contact.
8. Staff are required to know and follow all building safety and emergency evacuation plans.
9. In case of fire immediately evacuate everyone from the building according to emergency evacuation plans and call 911, followed by call to designated 1Voice emergency contact.
10. In case of any building or property damages staff must complete an incident report, and contact designated 1Voice emergency contact.

Recovery Community Centers are peer-operated centers that serve as local resources of community-based recovery support. People do not live at these centers, but rather these resources can help individuals build recovery capital at the community level by providing advocacy training, recovery information and resource mobilization, attendance of mutual support groups, social activities, and other community-based services. They may also help relationships among individuals in recovery, as well as community and family members. In turn, this increased recovery capital helps individuals initiate and sustain recovery over time.
