- Costumes, attire, language, and/or song lyrics must be elementary school appropriate and will need approval before dress rehearsal.
- No SOLO act may exceed the time constraint of 2 minutes.
- ◆ No **GROUP** act may exceed the time constraint of *2 minutes and 30 seconds*.
