For all those intrigued by the blockchain revolution, this is our startup manual based on personal experience. This is probably the first of many editions so hopefully we can help get you rolling.

Not this time. This will be among the first times in history that multigenerational wealth will be created without a great crime taking place.

FIAT EXCHANGES (THINK OF THESE AS BANKS, DONT TRUST THE BANKS!)

You want to be registered on several coin exchanges as during times of mania the exchanges get locked up and shut down (sometimes for days). You also don't want to be shut out if your one coin exchange gets hacked or some other digital problem. Where fiat refers to institutionally issued currency. If your not familiar, the literal translation of fiat is 'let it be' which refers to creation as God did in Genesis when he spoke the universe into existence. Yep, their really that arrogant.

Always transfer your coins/tokens to your wallet, never leave anything on a exchange!

1) Coinbase

This is a large, popular coin exchange that is easy to use and quick to register. Good for Bitcoin, Bitcoin Cash, Ethereum & Litecoin. (Accepts credit cards, 4% fee)

*A note about www.gdax.com. If you have a coinbase account, you have a gdax account. They are the same company. At time of this writing, it seems only useful for exchanging blockchain for blockchain, not blockchain for fiat in Canada. Your exodus wallet is much more useful and probably faster.

2) Coinsquare

As of time of this writing the platform is new and the author has limited use of it but it does work. Takes about 1 week from fiat currency sent to cryptos received. It does get faster as you build a history. (Accepts many payment forms, fees 0.25% - 5%)

There are hundreds of these exchanges available to you. I recommend, if you can find them, use decentralized exchanges as often as possible for your privacy and security.

This decentralized exchange is ETHER only and is very clunky and technical looking. Incredibly simple to use and efficient as an exchange. This is an ETH and ERC20 exchange only. The Etherdelta tutorial will work for the Forkdelta site. Fork delta is better in my opinion.

TIP: Transfer your ether and tokens to a wallet that you only use on exchanges, then send your ether and tokens to a wallet you never use on exchanges.

This is a great tool for converting between tokens. The Exodus wallet has this tool built in for you, but only services the tokens the wallet is compatible with. This is a pooled exchange. There are many blockchain to blockchain exchanges. Be paranoid, it will keep you safe.

Centralized crypto to crypto, and fiat to crypto.

WALLETS (Store your cryptos here)

Storing your cryptos in your own possession keeps them safe... from everyone but you. It is **CRITICALLY IMPORTANT** to print your keys and store them someplace safe. There is no customer service, your on your own. For more advance training on keeping yourself safe online,

WARNING: Whenever sending coins/tokens from your personal wallets always send a tiny amount first, then confirm on the block chain. After you have 20+ confirmations (blocks) send the full portion and check again.

This is an ETH only wallet. You can send ERC20 tokens and other ETH based tokens. Print your keys!



