Instances in the Old Testament giftings, where God gives to individuals, by His power, the ability to perform certain tasks:

- a. **Music/Creative Communication**: David and the chiefs of the service also set apart for the service the sons of Asaph, and of Heman, and of Jeduthun, <u>who prophesied with</u> <u>lyres, with harps, and with cymbals</u>. **1 Chronicles 25:1.**¹
- b. Seamstress/Tailor: You are to speak to all who are <u>specially skilled, whom I have filled</u> <u>with the spirit of wisdom</u>, so that they may make Aaron's garments to set him apart to minister as my priest. Exodus 28:3. See also 31:1-3, 10-11.
- c. Craftsmanship: Moses said to the Israelites, "See, <u>the LORD</u> has chosen Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah. ³¹He <u>has filled him with the Spirit of God—with skill, with understanding, with knowledge, and in all kinds of work—³²to design artistic designs, to work in gold, in silver, and in bronze, ³³and in cutting stones for their setting, and in cutting wood, to do work in every artistic craft. ³⁴ And he has put it in his heart to teach, he and Oholiab son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan. ³⁵He has filled them with skill to do all kinds of work as craftsmen, as designers, as embroiderers in blue, purple, and scarlet yarn and in fine linen, and as weavers. They are craftsmen in all the work and artistic designers. Exodus 35:30-35. See also 31:1-11.</u>
