

Minutes from Meeting held May 12, 2026

The May meeting of the South Shenango Township Supervisors was held on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, at the South Shenango Township Building, located at 6865 Collins Road, Jamestown, PA 16134. The meeting was called to order at 2:32 pm by Chairperson Joe Livingston. Present were Supervisors Joe Livingston and Jacob Andrew; Solicitor Brett Stedman; Roadmaster Jamie Fries; Property Main. Code Official Bob Goff and Secretary Rebecca Andrew. Five visitors signed in. Minutes from the April 14th meeting were reviewed and approved with a motion by Joe Livingston and a second by Jake Andrew. MC

Attorney's Report – Brett Stedman

Mr. Stedman introduced updates to the Wind Energy Facilities ordinance, emphasizing changes for review.

Joe Livingston made a motion to hold a public hearing for the Wind Energy Facilities Ordinance at 2:30 pm during the July meeting, and Jake Andrew seconded the motion. MC

Mr. Steadman presented a Data centers ordinance draft to the board and requested supervisor feedback.

Supervisors' Report –None

Roadmaster's Report – Jamie Fries

Jamie reported challenges in locating a facility to accept tires collected during clean-up days; this issue has now been resolved, as Dresnick's in Rockcreek will handle tire disposal. Jamie also informed the board that the steel roller's water pump is malfunctioning. Dan Smith located a rebuild kit and Jamie will attempt repairs; if these efforts are unsuccessful, replacement of the roller will be necessary.

Additionally, Jamie advised the board that salt brining operations are scheduled for next week.

Secretary's Report-Rebecca Andrew

The fire contract was mentioned, but without supervisor Mike Richter present, it will be revisited at the June meeting.

Scott Harding noted that 911 routinely notifies additional departments when an incident occurs in the area, as Jamestown has often been unable to respond.

Rebecca announced that clean-up days will be held May 27th and 28th 2026 from 8am to 6pm.

Joe Livingston moved to approve the April bills with a second by Jake Andrew. MC
