Joining our Club includes membership of the Victorian Rifle Association (VRA), enabling you to compete statewide & nationally in a number of target shooting disciplines & supports our Club which is one of the oldest & also the largest Rifle Club in Victoria.

WHERE: Lang Lang Rifle Club is the closest and most convenient location from Melbourne City. Just 35 minutes from Frankston/Dandenong. Located near the Lang Lang township ... see the map below.

TWO RANGES AVAILABLE – 'Centre Fire' Rifle 100 yds (Max Calibre is .318 Cal) and 'Small Bore' for .22LR @ 20 & 50 yards (only Sub Sonic Ammunition to be used i.e. 1100 fps & below)

WHEN: SATURDAY'S ONLY - from 9.00am till 10.00am (please arrive at 8:45am to 'Sign In')


Please note that sighting in is conducted on our main range before the normal days shooting activities commence, so please arrive promptly as latecomers may not be able to be accommodated depending upon the days shooting program.

- MOST IMPORTANT WHAT TO BRING:
- Your current firearms licence, which must be presented at sign in.
- Arrive with the BOLTS out of your rifles (a VRA Rule)
- Muzzle brakes may not be used on our range & must be removed if fitted.
- Please make sure you rifle has been at least bore sighted and Arrive with the BOLTS out of your rifles (a VRA Rule)
- you have a cleaning kit with you if it is new rifle (so that you can 'season' the barrel in)
- Hearing Protection is Mandatory (eye protection is optional but advisable)
- A Mat to lay on (all shooting is conducted in the 'Prone' position)
- Dress according to the weather on the day as the firing point is not sheltered

Please be aware that no dogs are permitted on the range & that all persons under the age of 18 must be under constant adult supervision.
