WHAT DO I DO?

I try to make sure that everyone under 18 years old is safe, whether they are playing or just socialising at the club.

I check all your coaches, helpers and committee so that they are OK to look after you.

No child should ever be harmed, bullied, picked on or left out!

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

If you are worried about anything, start by talking to your Coach, Junior Organiser or me, or anyone else you know is in charge.

I'll then ask you and other people what's happened. I'll write everything down in case we need to ask someone else for advice, but what you tell me will only be shown to people who really need to know.
