A Childlike Faith

18 At that time the disciples came to Jesus and asked, "Who, then, is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" He called a little child to him, and placed the child among them. And he said: "Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore, whoever takes the lowly position of this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. And whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me." - Matthew 18:1-5

A few summers ago, we asked families to keep their children in our contemporary worship service instead of sending them to children's church and we did everything we could to make it a fun, family friendly hour of worship. We offered popcorn and drinks in the lobby. We brought some bean bags into the front of the space and invited the kids to sit there during worship. We sang songs and we danced. We had children and youth read the scriptures. And, we watched a different Pixar animated short each week and I preached about the Biblical truths illustrated in those fun little films. The first week, I preached about the Golden Rule as seen in the short For the Birds. At the end of the sermon, I asked the church to consider the interactions they knew they would have in the week to come and how they could be ready to live out the Golden Rule in those interactions.

Then, I started to ask a few hypothetical questions:

"How will you treat the waiter or waitress who serves you a meal when you go out to eat?" I asked. A tiny little hand shot up from one of the bean bags in front. I looked down at a sweet angel named Aubrey and nodded to her to answer.

"Friendly."

"How will you treat the grocery store clerk?" I asked.

Little hand. A nod.

"Friendly."

"How will you act when your parents ask you to clean up your room?"

"Friendly."

"When your brother or sister asks you to play with them?"

"Friendly."

Question after question, this child showed us all how to answer, how to love others as ourselves. Her answers were simple and direct. She was clearly ready for the week she had ahead, which she had already told us was full of dance camps and VBS.

"Friendly."

I'm pretty sure she didn't know exactly what I meant when I said that if we asked for the little part of God that is in each of us to help us see the little bit of God that is in every other person we meet that we would find that, one interaction at a time, it's not as hard as the world might tell us it is to follow the Golden Rule.

She may not have understood those words exactly, but Aubrey knew what it meant. With her hand raised eagerly in the air to share what she knew, it was obvious it was right there in her heart and soul. She knew it as well as anyone else in the room.

Although children are not allowed to be present at the gatherings that take place during walks, let us never forget to take our own childlike faith with us

when we work walks, when we attend opening or candlelight or closing, and wherever else life takes us.
