


## TRAKER® METHOD TO INSTALL CONTRACTION JOINTS IN CONCRETE



The **TRAKER** System is manually operated for installing early-entry contraction joints in concrete. An insertion disc embeds Trak Joint Tape flush with the surface of fresh concrete. Finishing operations go over the tape. The Trak Joint Tape remains in the concrete to form the weakened plane.

## **Advantages:**

- ⇒ Cost is 75% less than early-entry sawcutting.
- ⇒ Installation speed is 4 times faster than early-entry sawcutting.
- ⇒ No silica dust is produced.
- ⇒ Activation of contraction joints is assured due to early-entry installation in fresh concrete.
- ⇒ Trak Joint® Tape:
  - Material cost is less than \$0.05 per linear foot.
  - Consistently embeds to the proper depth and vertical orientation.
  - Prevents rainwater from weakening subbase soils.
  - Covers vertical faces of concrete in joint for curing.
