

This Deed of Confirmation made this
twenty fourth day of March in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight be-
tween William Woodward of the first part, and
Samuel Lewis and Osmond Boggswell of the second part
all of the city of Cincinnati and State of Ohio.—

Whereas the said William Woodward on the twenty
first day of November in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and twenty six by his Deed
of conveyance of that date, gave, granted, and aliened,
unto the said Samuel Lewis and Osmond Boggswell
certain lands and tenements mentioned and described
in said Deed of conveyance, in Trust and for certain
uses and purposes therein specified and directed. And
wheras the General Assembly of the State of Ohio, with
a view to facilitate the performance of said trust and to
serve to the poor children of the city of Cincinnati the
benefits and advantages intended by the said William
Woodward by the said Deed of conveyance, on the twenty
fourth day of January in the year one thousand eight
hundred and twenty seven passed an act declaring the
said Samuel Lewis, Osmond Boggswell and Jonathan Hancock
and their successors a body corporate by the name and
style of the Trustees of the Woodward Free Gram-
mar School, Now this Indenture witnesseth
that the said William Woodward in consideration
of the promises, and for the purpose of carrying

into complete effect the objects contemplated by said
Deed of conveyance and by said act of incorporation, has
given, granted, ratified, approved and confirmed, and by
these presents does give, grant, ratify, approve, and con-
firm and conform unto the said Samuel Lewis and Osmond
Coggswell as such trustees and in their corporate capacity
aforesaid, and to their successors the lands, tenements and
premises mentioned and described in said Deed of convey-
ance. To have and to hold the same unto them the
said Samuel Lewis and Osmond Coggswell and their suc-
cessors in their corporate capacity as aforesaid and in
no other way whatever. In testimony whereof the said
William Woodward has to these presents set his hand
and Seal the day and year first written. And the
said Samuel Lewis and Osmond Coggswell have also to
these presents set their hands and seals on the same
day, thereby signifying and declaring their acceptance of
the trust created by said deed of conveyance bearing
date the twenty first day of November one thousand and
eight hundred and twenty six, and also manifesting
the corporate character in which they have taken a convey-
ance of the lands, tenements, and premises mentioned and
described in that Deed.
