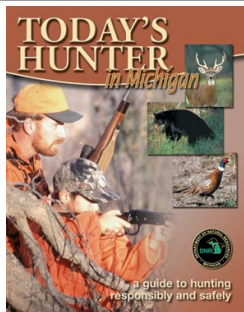
Big Gun/Game Night 2025
