## **NRA Personal Protection In the Home (Michigan Concealed Pistol License certification class)**

Dear CPL class participant,

We look forward to providing Michigan Concealed Pistol License (CPL) certification training and provide the following information for your convenience and safety.

**Friday evening:** This is the "legal" section and requires paper and pencil/pen, your class fee and membership dues if not already paid. Registration is from 6:00 to 6:15 pm, with the class starting promptly at 6:15. We expect to finish by 9:30. You will receive the instruction materials at this time, and will use those materials this evening and on Saturday.

**DO NOT BRING FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION TO THE FRIDAY EVENING SESSION!**

**Saturday:** Class will begin promptly at 8:15 am, and we plan to finish by 5:30 pm. Late arrivals will be re-scheduled for the next class session (none scheduled at this time).

This is a full day with a 30 minute break for lunch around noon. Bring your own lunch. Coffee is available at no charge. Pop and water is available for 50¢ per can/bottle. A refrigerator and microwave are available for your use.

Approximately two hours of outdoor range time is part of the Saturday class. Make sure you bring appropriate clothing. Nothing short of extremely severe weather conditions will cause postponement or cancellation of the range activity.

The Saturday session begins with classroom activity then range firing, course review and testing in the afternoon. We may revise the sequence depending on weather conditions.

If you need to borrow one of our pistols for the range session, please make that arrangement in advance and be prepared to pay for the ammunition.

Unless advance, alternative arrangements have been made you will need the following:

## REQUIRED FOR THE SATURDAY SESSIONS.

1. A handgun (one that works) and ammunition for it (98 rounds minimum). **DO NOT BRING FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION INTO THE CLASSROOM!**
2. Eye and ear protection.
3. Pen and/or pencil(s) and note paper.
4. Class material and notes from the Friday session, including the *NRA Guide to the Basics of Personal Protection in the Home* book. You will need these for reference and the test given at the end of the day.

**Note: No holsters are to be used on the range during the Saturday activity!**

## OPTIONAL MATERIALS THAT YOU MAY BRING

1. Speed loaders for revolvers and extra magazines for semi-automatics.
2. Speed loader and magazine pouches.
3. Knee pads.
4. Owner's manual for the gun you will be using.
5. Extra ammunition (recommended). **NO FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION IN THE CLASSROOM!**
6. Bug spray and sun screen if the weather is warm.
