RIFLE RANGE ISSUES: PLEASE BE AWARE!!!!!!!!

There have been several complaints and observations of unsafe practices and abuse. **On the 100-yard range**.

#1: Clay targets were shot that left a mess down at the backstop.

There's a sign right at the bench's that states NO BREAKABLE TARGETS, paper targets only.

#2: The 50-yard backstop has the top support board and full of bullet holes.

There is no reason that board should have any bullet holes whatsoever. Those bullets have a 90% chance of going over the backstop. **An extremely unsafe practice.** Be aware where you're placing your targets on that backstop.

#3: The bolts and ears on the steel targets continually are being shot off.

Again, there is no reason those should be damaged other than someone intentionally shoots at them. We will not be replacing the steel targets at this time. The cost is high for them and they continually are abused.

THIS IS YOUR CLUB AND YOUR SHOOTING RANGES. IF YOU SEE SOMONE ABUSING THE SHOOTING RANGES, SPEAK UP. IT ONLY TAKES ONE UNSAFE PRACTICE AND OR ABUSE TO CLOSE DOWN THE RANGES FOR EVERYBODY.

HUNTING RULES & REGULATIONS FOR FIN & FEATHER CLUB MEMBERS ONLY IF YOU ARE NOT A FIN & FEATHER CLUB MEMBER, YOU CANNOT HUNT ON THE CLUB GROUNDS.

Hunting Hours (Rifle, Muzzle Loading & Bow)

Bow Hunting only – October 1 to November 15

Rifle hunting between November 15 to January 1st

No Hunting Starting November 15th through January 1st from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM daily to allow members to use the ranges

No Hunting after 10:00 AM on Tuesday from November 15 to January 1st

- ***Firearm hours are from legal hunting opening hours to 10:00 AM and from 2:00 PM till legal hunting closing hours ONLY (except after 10:00 AM on Tuesdays no hunting).
- ***Firearm hunting is NOT allowed during the hours of 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM daily, when all ranges (pistol, rifle, skeet, trap, bow, etc.) will be open.
- ***Hunters to be off club property during the above club shooting hours.

To hunt on club property, you <u>MUST</u> be a Fin & Feather club member in good standing.

No guests of Club Members allowed.

Other Rules

Hunters MUST carry their club identification card and display it, when asked to identify them selves.

Hunting on club property is on a first come, first serve basis.

Due to safety concerns, all hunters MUST obey the Mason County Fin & Feather Club hunting policies as well as the Michigan DNR regulations.

Your blind / stand, MUST have your identification (name, phone number) on it and be visible.

The above rules & regulations are to protect hunters and Fin & Feather Club shooters. Any violation may mean dismissal of Fin & Feather Club memberships.


