Fun with Fungi at Fin and Feather Club!



Date and Location

*Friday, September 25th, 2026, from 9:00am to ~12:00pm.

At ~8:45am, meet at the Fin and Feather Club of Mason County, 3276 North Darr Road, Scottville, Michigan 49454 – the parking area is near the main building.

During this event you will learn about different types of fungi (including mushrooms) growing in the forests of Michigan. Specific topics will include identification of wild fungi (including edible and non-edible species) and the basic biology of mushrooms and other fungi. We will also

discuss the ecological importance of such fungi in the forest. This event will take place at Fin and Feather Club in Scottville and will be led by Josh Shields, FAP forester and wildlife biologist with the Manistee and Mason-Lake Conservation Districts, and naturalist Linda Scribner. Both Linda and Josh are Certified Wild-Foraged Mushroom Experts through the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development. PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS WILL NOT BE A GUIDED HIKE – Rather, you will wander the property on your own or in groups and Josh Shields will also wander and help you identify fungi, while Linda Scribner will be stationed at a central location where you can bring her specimens. There will also be tables with information about fungi.

Rimfire Fun Shoot

Sunday September 13th Starting at 1:00 pm.

We will be having another Rimfire Fun Shoot on the 13th. Weather permitting. Light rain we will shoot since we have covering. Thunderstorms we will cancel.

Again, you will shoot steel targets at ranges out to 100 yards. We will also be timing each round this time (roughly 2 minutes) to add a little more challenge to the game. Like before each position will have several targets and ranges to shoot at. All stages will be 10 shots (50 rounds total) The recommendation is to sight your rifle in at 50 yards. and use quality ammo.

Equipment: Any 22 LR rifle, (No magnums or 17 cal.) Sandbags, Backpacks, and attached Bipods are allowed. Bringing a good pair of binoculars does help in figuring out where the targets are and identifying hits. We recommend having extra magazines if your gun uses them. If not don't worry. We'll adjust things so you can reload more ammo if necessary. There will be a **mandatory safety meeting at the 200/300**

Yard Ranges a 1:00pm, shooting will begin after the meeting. You also may want to bring a lawn chair since there is limited places to sit.

Cost is \$10, youth under 17 are free with adult supervision required

Tactical Style Plate Shoot

The Fin and Feather Club of Mason County hosted a tactical style plate shoot on Sunday, August 23rd. Had about 20 people show up. This was for non-magnum center-fire and rimfire handguns. Shooters entered both divisions or they could shoot multiple guns. Entry fee was \$10.

The fee was waived for minors if they had their own equipment. A parent or guardian needed to be present with them. There was a tactical style plate shoot with 4 stages with shooting each target stage 3 times.

There was 24 shooters including 1 youth. 4 challenging stages.

Stage 1: engaged 6 white plates partially hidden behind red no shoot plates.

Stage 2: alternately shooting the moving target and Texas Star combination.

Stage 3: seated plate rack

Stage 4: seated on the ground and alternately shooting a spinning target and dueling tree.

The class "finale" shoot is next month and can only be shot by class participants, but it would be worthwhile for anyone interested to see what kind of skills are learned and the very dynamic shooting it enables.

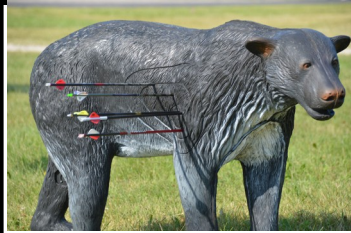

Outstanding Fin & Feather Club Members

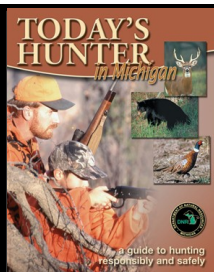
Once again, it's time to start thinking of that special person or persons that you would like to nominate for Outstanding Fin & Feather Club Member of the Year.
