

Bed Bug Service Procedures/Prep-List

PROCEDURES

- Exterior hallway, common areas, and door to unit will receive a crack and crevice treatment. Hallway will receive a surface/fan spray.
- Inside the unit, the entire unit will receive a crack and crevice treatment along the base boards. This will create a barrier around the unit to help prevent bugs from spreading throughout the building. Next, all mattresses will be treated; both sides and seams. We will follow up with a general surface spray throughout the unit with heavy concentration in the bedrooms, behind dressers/bed frames, pictures, light plates and outlets.
- We will repeat the procedure 2 times within 2-5 days.

PREP-LIST

Resident preparation is key to success of bed bug elimination. Prior to the initial bed bug service the following items must be completed:

1. Vacuum and de-clutter unit
2. Strip all beds and vacuum mattress surfaces and along seams
3. Remove everything from inside bedroom and hall closets, dressers, night stands, including toys, boxes, etc. Then vacuum those areas.
4. Gather and wash ALL clothing, towels, linens, and store in plastic bags or bins in living room until after the treatment (if possible use laundry facility outside of property and wash items in hot water).
5. Dispose of used vacuum bag by putting bag in a plastic bag and seal.
6. Move furniture from the baseboards - approx. 3 feet (critical in bedroom areas)
7. Make sure there is no contact with unit (people or animals) for at least 2 hours after each treatment
