Bass Clef The two dots C denote the pitch F

Key signature A series of sharps or flats that give which pitches are altered

Octave CDEFGABC

Circle of 5ths A model that serves as a way to order all sharps & flat key signatures (clockwise or counter-clockwise)

Time Signature $\frac{4}{4}$ → number of beats per measure

Treble Clef Second line from bottom denotes the pitch G

Major Scale WWWh WWWh

Dotted notes Add $\frac{1}{2}$ value to note $d. = d + \text{half note}$

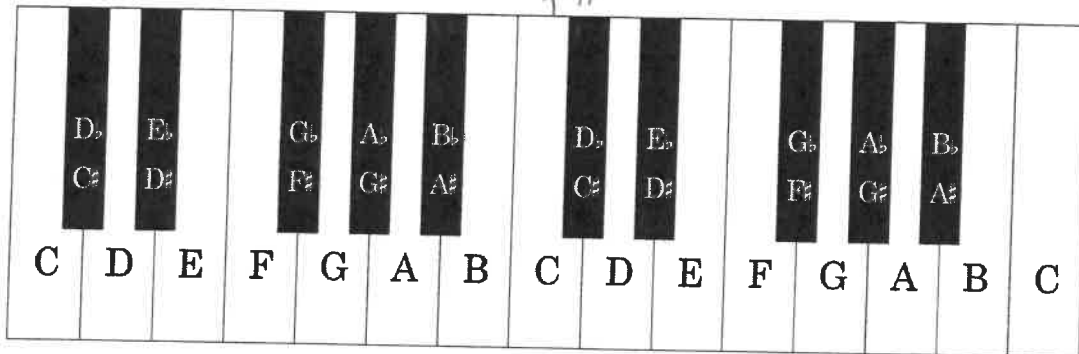
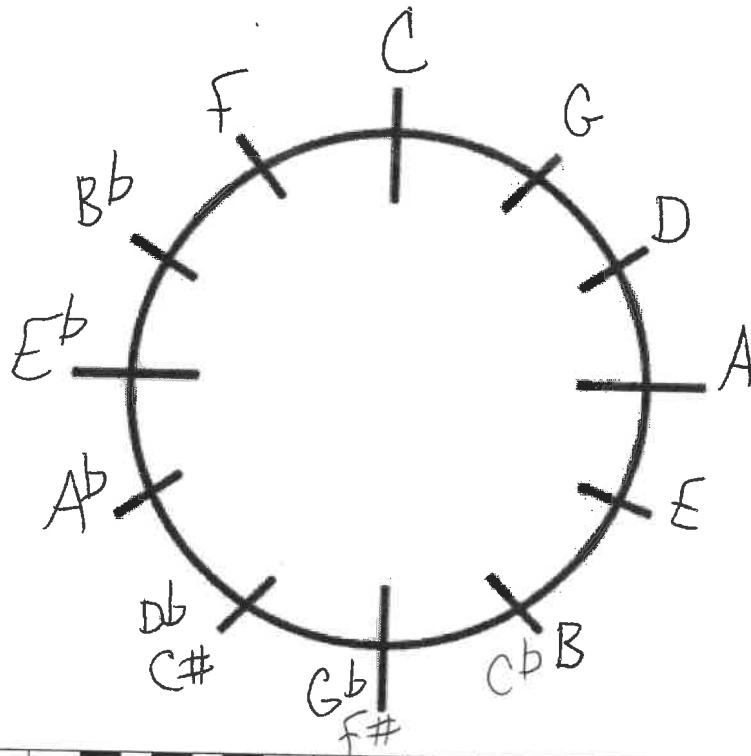
