

In order to make everyone's visit to the Twelve Step Recovery Club an enjoyable, comfortable and constructive experience, the board of Trustees has established the following policies. All patrons of the club, guests and members of the groups using the club are required to respect and follow these policies.

1. Absolutely NO alcohol or illegal drugs are to be brought into the club or on club property. The club is a no
2. NO firearms, ammunition or weapons or any kind are to be brought into the club.
3. Animals, except legitimate service animals, are prohibited from entering the club at all times.
4. Fighting, either physically or verbally is prohibited. Excessive foul or abusive language is prohibited.

9. NO ONE is permitted behind the counter except the counter person on duty and any officer or trustee of the
10. The club will not interfere or intervene in any actions of the group members or guests unless it is a violation of these policies. The club respects the autonomy of the groups, their rules and traditions.
11. All patrons and guests of the club must park in the marked spaces in the upper or lower parking lot. Parking in the lower club entrance drive is reserved for the counter person on duty and persons making deliveries.
12. Destruction of or intentional damage of club property or the property of any other person is prohibited.

Any person who fails to abide by the policies may be asked to leave. Any group that fails to support and enforce these policies may be asked to find another location. Any action taken for the violation of these policies is at the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees on a case-by-case basis.
