Market Lavington Parish Council does not accept liability for personal damages, losses, or injuries sustained during the event. Any personal property brought to the event is done so at your own risk.

The Council reserves the right to refuse admission.

No alcohol is allowed to be bought on site by members of the public. Any alcoholic drinks to the event may be confiscated on entry. Alcohol is available from the licenced bar.

The Council shall be entitled to confiscate (1) any items listed below and (2) any other item that we consider to be dangerous or inappropriate. The Council shall not be liable for any loss, theft or damage to confiscated items. Prohibited items are – air horns, BBQ's, Chinese lanterns, firearms, fireworks, flares, gas canisters/cylinders, glass of any kind.

A wrist band will be placed on your wrist. This must remain intact through the whole time you are on site, if you remove the wristband you will be challenged by site security or a volunteer. If in the unlikely event the wristband becomes broken, you must go to the Event Control where a replacement will be issued in exchange for the broken wristband.

All pets must be on a lead, please clear up after your pet. Any animal left in a vehicle will be reported to the RSPCA or the Police. We will, if we believe an animal is suffering, remove the animal from the vehicle and hand it to the appropriate authority. We will use force if necessary to enter the vehicle. There are no kennels on site.

Search is a condition of entry and presence at the event, including random searches during the event.

This is a family event and unruly behaviour including excessive swearing will not be tolerated.

Strictly no trading on site without the Council's consent.

You must comply with any reasonable direction of a volunteer. If any volunteer is threatened in any way or you fail to comply with the instructions of the volunteer, you will be asked to leave the event.

For the purpose of promoting this or any future events only, your entry is explicit consent to your image being used in any promotional material. The copyright of which will remain the property of the Council. Your attendance with anyone under 18 years of age means that you give the above consent on their behalf. This includes filming by the police or security staff for reasons of security.

We will not accept criminal activity in any form including criminal damage/fighting/use of illegal substances. If such activities are carried out, you will be asked to leave and the police may be called to attend.
