PEBBLECREEK HIKING CLUB INCIDENT/INJURY REPORT

Purpose: The intent of the Incident/Injury Report is to capture information from injuries, or other unplanned hiking events so that actions to prevent a reoccurrence can be identified and implemented.

What to report: Any serious injury, or incident with the potential for serious injury. This would include injuries requiring more than "Self-Treatment" by the hiker, significant use of Club 1st Aid Kit items, or any 911 call.

Responsibilities: The Hike Leader will determine whether an incident should be reported based on severity and/or earning potential. The Hike Leader is responsible for completing the Report Form and submitting it to the Safety
Committee or Hiking Club President for review.
