

The system allows for complex queries to be used to look up data in unique ways. By providing this function the club no longer needs to provide PDF documents of the Hike Description Library – all hikers, coordinators and leaders can access data in real time in a manner best for each individual.

Browsing the database can be achieved in by accessing the full system or via the browse panels in the home page of the club website. Be aware that there is less functionality (no export or print capabilities and limited paging flexibility) provided via the club website due to software incompatibilities.

This document explains the Hike Description Browse function and provides examples to start with. The final page offers some advanced capabilities including the ability to create your own filter buttons for repeat searches.
