



Moulton Chapel FC – Equality and Diversity Policy

Football is for everyone and should be enjoyed by those who want to participate in it, whether they are players, supporters, visiting spectators, coaches, officials, indeed anyone of any age who wants to use the facilities at our ground.

Moulton Chapel Football Club in all its activities will not discriminate or in any way treat anyone less favourably on grounds of: Age; Disability; Gender Re-assignment; Pregnancy and Maternity; Marriage and Civil Partnership; Race; Religion or Belief; Sex Equality; Sexual Orientation. These are known as the 'Protected Characteristics' under the Equality Act 2010.

We are committed to taking positive action where inequalities exist and through awareness raising events and activities to promote both equality and the eradication of discrimination in football.

Moulton Chapel Football Club commits itself to the immediate investigation, when brought to its attention, of any concerns or complaints about discriminatory behaviour. Where this is found to be the case appropriate disciplinary action will be taken.
