Moulton Chapel FC will adopt and support the FA Respect Programme. All players have a responsibility to always adhere to the following Code of Conduct:

I will:

- ✓ Study the laws of the game and always adhere to them.
- ✓ Listen to instructions and respect what my coach says.
- ✓ Display good self-discipline and always behave in a way that reflects well on the club.
- ✓ Respect ALL other players, coaches, officials, and parents
- ✓ Play to win fairly, encourage and praise others.
- ✓ Always do my best, even if we are losing to a stronger team.
- ✓ Show my commitment and enthusiasm for the team whether selected to play or not.
- ✓ Inform my coach if I cannot train or play in a match.
- ✓ Inform my coach of any medical needs.
- ✓ Wear correct equipment always including shin guards.
- ✓ Bring a drink to training and all fixtures.
- ✓ Set high standards by being on time, being polite and keeping your kit clean.
- ✓ Shake hands with the other team players and referee at the end of the game.
- ✓ Talk to someone I trust, for example my parents or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.
- ✓ Remove all Jewellery before each fixture or training session.

I Won't:

- ✗ Attempt to sway the referee's decision by claiming a foul, by diving or by appealing for free kicks, offside etc.
- ✗ Argue with officials, parents, coaches, or players.
- ✗ Lose my self-control by retaliating.
- ✗ Overreact when celebrating a goal.
- ✗ Be rude to my team-mates, the other team, the referee, spectators, or my coach/manager.
- ✗ Make comments on social media that are critical, abusive, or threatening.
