

Moulton Chapel FC – Spectator, Parent or Guardian Code of Conduct

Moulton Chapel FC will adopt and support the FA Respect Programme. All Spectators and Parents/Carers have a responsibility to always adhere to the following Code of Conduct:

I will:

- ✓ Remain outside the field of play and behind/within the Designated Spectator Area (where provided).
- √ Encourage and praise players.
- ✓ Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- \checkmark Show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials & spectators.
- √ Always respect the match officials' decisions.
- ✓ Exhibit good touchline behaviour by showing respect for all others involved in the game.
- √ Help with player commitment, punctuality, and appearance.
- ✓ Encourage player self-discipline, language, clean kit, shin guards and drinks for training and matches (home and away, including friendlies or tournaments).
- √ Support the Club.

In addition, when attending training and matches (home and away, including friendlies or tournaments):

I will:

- √ Remember that children play for FUN.
- \checkmark Let the coaches do their job and not confuse the players by giving instruction from the touchline.
- √ Encourage the players to respect the opposition and match officials.

I will not:

- χ Criticise a player for making a mistake (mistakes are part of learning).
- χ Engage in public criticism of the match officials.
- x Engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.
- x Attempt to questions the referee's decision.
- χ Put pressure on players to perform at a higher level than they are able.
- χ Argue with officials, parents, coaches, or players.
- χ Enter the field of play.
- x Make comments on social media that are critical, abusive, or threatening.
