The President's Corner: Van N4ERM

Field Day 2016!!

Our June meeting will preview our participation in the 2016 Field Day event. **Bob WA4WHV** is our overall in charge (OIC). The ARRL calls Field Day an event., NOT a contest. Historically for CFARS it has been BOTH an event and a contest. In my simplistic way of thinking, anytime points are awarded and comparative scores are posted, you have an event that is a context! We've always done "respectably" in the past (#2 or #3 in NC). This time we're aiming for first place. Our own **George KN4ODS** has volunteered to lead the SSB station. He needs lots of help to keep the station running for the full 24 hours. So VOLUNTEER! His presentation at May's meeting on "Best Contesting Practices" was just SUPER.

The Field Day set-up process looks like this:

- Friday, 24 June - Pick up and deliver equipment (tents, tables & chairs, towers, antennas. generator, power system, cables, etc.) to the Field Day site, adjacent to the Hendricks Complex parting lot.
- Saturday, 25 June - After breakfast, set up and check all equipment and stations prior to the 1400 hours (2PM) start time, then operate continuously for 24 straight hours!
- Sunday, 25 June - Continue operations until 1400 hours (2PM), then break everything down and pack it away until next year's event. And DON'T FORGET the POTLUCK Come join us for Field Day and get on the air. Bring your friends and family and get THEM on the air, too!




Field Day (circa 1975)
