





Build is Better than Buy By "El Cheapo" N4ERM

Our friend **Bob WA4WHV** is an awesome builder. He is most at home working in wood and plastic where he has a complete shop in his basement. Here are some views of his most recent creation: a lovely set of portable paddles for CW during our "QRP outings in the park."

The key is housed in a lexan and wood box. Insert the key into the box in one direction and it's protected for travel (paddles over the wooden block); insert in the other and it's ready to operate (front of key against block).





Here's the key travel-stowed (block of wood behind key).


Here's the key ready for use (wood now in front of key)

Here's a close-up of the works out of the box. The basis for the key is the wooden "T" that Bob cut. He mounted pieces of copper sheeting to both the horizontal and vertical portions of the "T" to make the paddles and contacts; paddles outside the horizontal, contacts with points in the middle on the vertical. A shielded 2-wire cable was connected one wire to each paddle and the braid ground to the contacts on each side. The paddles were finished with lexan tabs and the whole thing mounted (glued) on a lexan base.


Bob beveled both sides of the base and countersunk a groove in the wooden box so that the key slid into the box and rested on a wooden stop at one end of the box. Inserted with the paddles over the wooden stop and the key was ready for travel. When inserted other way around and it was ready to operate. Great work, Bob!

Let us know when you're ready to go into mass production to sell these as a kit. Put the name Bigali or Kent on them and they'll sell for \$\$ hundreds!
