

North Carolina QSO Party CHANGES THE RULES

CFARS has won the last three NC QSO Party contests. The rules remained the same for all three years. Possibly as a result of these convincing victories, the Raleigh group that runs the contest has changed the rules. Larger clubs complained that the shortness of the contest (only 10 hours) and allowing only one club radio on the air, limited the number of club participants. For this reason some wanted a change in the rules to allow multiple club stations on the air (more stations = more member participation). 


