

Antenna Installation Complete

I'm pleased to report that the antenna serving the Cumberland County Emergency Shelter at Pine Forest Senior High School was successfully installed and tested. Yours truly and the Cape Fear Amateur Radio Society (CFARS) President, **Dale Mohr, AK4YS**, were joined on site by **Larry Melton** of the Cumberland County Schools, and his supervisor. The two School personnel asked pertinent questions, quickly understood the work to be accomplished, and formulated a plan of action to get on with the same-day installation.

It was determined that the coax (RG-213) was probably too thick for the short distance from the antenna to the interior hall, a straight-line distance of approximately 10 feet.. CFARS provided a suitable length of RG-8X coax to route from the antenna, through a suitable wall penetration (see photo), to the hallway.
