# March 2014 Club Meeting Minutes:

On March 17th the Cape Fear Amateur Radio Society meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by **Dale AK4YS**. The meeting was held in Clark Hall of Methodist University. **Dale AK4YS** led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance. **Elton W4VGW** led the invocation. **Dale AK4YS** led the introductions in the normal CFARS style.

**Kelly N4EWG**, made a motion to accept the minutes for February, seconded by **Van N4ERM**, with a date correction for Field Day June 28 - 29 with setup on Friday June 27th. By vote the motion passed.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**Treasurer: Chuck, KJ4RV** gave a financial report. We are solvent!

Repeater: Bill KU4W reported on the club repeaters. Issues with the 2 meter repeaters have been solved at the present time. The 6 meter repeater is working now after a cold solder joint repair. The 440 machine is working normally. Van N4ERM added Bill KU4W and Doug W4DWH donated time and gas for continued support of our repeaters. He suggested they be reimbursed for the costs involved. Pat N4UGH made a motion, seconded by Tripp KJ4BJKD, to give \$100 each for all they have spent to support the repeaters. By vote the motion passed.

Net Manager: Chuck, KJ4RV reported on the nets. Net time and traffic are down from January. This has a lot to do with February being a shorter month. Total check-ins were 471 (16.8 per net). Total net time was 561 minutes (average of 20 minutes per net session). David KR4OE added a historical note from the early 90's - net participation averaged 40 check-ins per net. Starting in 2000 net participation began to taper off.

Health & Welfare: No report.

**Membership: David KR40E** reported on membership. Currently we have 80 members. A final total will be available next month. Membership gives you the right to vote on club issues.
