It was a great success.

WB4ARC Dan, made a motion to accept the minutes for April with a correction of **Tripp's** call sign, seconded by **Van N4ERM**. By vote the motion passed.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Treasurer: Chuck, KJ4RV gave a report on income and expenses. After payment of equipment insurance, PO Box rental and services rendered we are solvent!

Repeater: Bill KU4W reported issues with the 2 meter repeater have been addressed by Van N4ERM, Irv K3IRV and himself. The 146.910 machine has been replaced by a backup repeater to allow for in depth diagnostics. The 6 meter repeater has issues with the receive section. It may have to be sent out for repairs. The 440 machine interference is being looked into and its operating normally. He urged all to participate to make the Possom Trot chapter #1. Van N4ERM gave a diagnostic report of procedures involved in the recent repair attempts on the 146.910 repeater. The antenna and coax were tested with no issues. The problems we are having are internal to the repeater. Van N4ERM suggested we invest a maximum of \$400.00 to upgrade the power supply, battery and power distribution methods for the repeater with Anderson Power Pole equipment. Kelly, N4EWG, made a motion, seconded by Bill KU4W to upgrade the equipment not to exceed \$400.00. By vote the motion passed. Bill KU4W reminded all of the upcoming 10-10 digital contest.
