Purpose: To promote CFARS member activity on both the local nets and during routine daily activities on both the 2 meter and 440 club repeaters.

Overview: The contest is simple. At the end of the 30-day period the person with the most points wins. Utilizing the CFARS 2 meter and 440 repeaters contacts will be tallied by each individual as per the rules described below. Logs will not be required; however, the attached scoresheet will be required for submission by 4 May 2020. Contacts and scoring will be summarized on this scoresheet using the honor system.

Methodology and scoring:

1. One point will be awarded for each log in for both the Possum Trot Net and the evening CFARS net. A total of two points daily.

2. Two points will be awarded for each 2 meter, and 3 points for each 440 contact during times other than net times during the course of each day. There is no maximum points in these categories. Points will be awarded for each unique call sign contacted during each day on each repeater. ie...If a contact is made with XX3XYZ on both the 2m and 440 repeaters, that would be 5 points, two for the 2m repeater and three for the 440 repeaters.

3. HF: One point for each HF contact up to a maximum of 5 points. These contacts can be by whatever mode or modes you choose. The limitation on 5 contacts is in the interest of those who are still required to work each day and may not have the opportunity to "play radio" as much as others. Limiting this category to 5 contacts will still allow them to get on the air in the evenings or when not working and still be competitive.

4. Bonus Points: Bonus points will be awarded for a contact with a club official. One contact with any of the following callsigns will be allowed for 50 or 25 bonus points respectively during the course of the contest. Additional contacts with the same official will count as a normal QSO. 50 points: KI4W, AK4YS, KJ4RV, KJ4OFD 25 points: KN4XP, KM4ODT, KI4YRH, W4MLW, KI4EZL, K4CFB, K4FET

5. Technician Category: Presently we have quite a few members who are Technicians without HF radios and/or with reduced privileges. If you are in this position, we are also offering a Technician category in the contest. A separate prize will be awarded.

6. Scoresheets: Scoresheets will be submitted to George (KM4ODS). Email: KM4ODS@gmail.com NLT 1700 EST 4 Mat 2020.

- 7. Winners will receive a fantastic prize at the next scheduled CFARS meeting.
