Old Business: David KR40E talked about the 50th Anniversary of CFARS. He asked if we wanted to get a 1x1 callsign for the event, we will use **K4MN** for the event. It will be 11/18 (Monday) thru 11/24 (Sunday). October 19 Methodist University will be hosting an Education Expo for children. There will be various military units, one of the jump teams from Fort Bragg. We have been asked to come and participate. It will be along the lines of what we do for the Boy Scouts (set up stations and allow them to get on the radio and make contacts.)

Bob will provide loop antenna and balun. **Van KG6HYJ** and **Bill KJ4OFD** will handle the tower. Tower motor has been repaired. Bill and Van will test on Wednesday. Bill will deliver on Friday. **George KM4ODS** will handle the SSB station. Satellite comms will be done by **Ferguson KK4MCY** and **Van KG6HYJ**. Training will be done by **Dale AK4YS**. He has also volunteered to provide some food. **John KN4ROM** volunteered to head the GOTA station. **Marty W4MLW** will handle Public Relations. **Bill KJ4OFD** and **Joe W3OJO** will pass traffic. **Bob WA4WHV** has agreed to be the Safety Manager. **George KM4ODS** will make the web submission and tally the contacts and make the needed reports.
