THE CFARS 440 REPEATER Try it and you will like it!

Okay fellow Ham Radio Operators. I wanted to write an article regarding the CFARS 440 repeater. This repeater has not gotten a lot of press and if you are not a regular attender to the monthly meetings, you probably are not fully aware of how this repeater is linked.

Currently, it is linked to the East Coast Reflector in the mornings and there is some good content that you may enjoy.

There are two nets: The Morning Brew from 8:00 to 9:00 The Second Cup from 9:00 to 10:00

Each of these will usually have a subject each morning and the subjects have quite a range of interest.

The following is a complete list of nets that are available on the 440 repeater.

The CFARS 440 repeater is linked as follows:

- Weekdays (except holidays): Link to the East Coast Reflector Morning
- Brew net from 8AM to 9AM. The Second Cup from 9AM to 10AM.
- Weekdays: Link to Carolina440 from 12PM until 4PM.
- Tuesday: Link to the East Coast Reflector weekly net at 8PM until about 11PM.
- Thursday: Link to the WVHFA swapnet at 8PM until completed.
- Friday: Link to the WinSystem TechNet at 9:30PM until about 11PM.

This is a great option for Operators at the Technician level to interact with folks from around the world during these nets. Give it a try and I think you will be pleased.

These club repeaters are there for your use. There is a lot of work to keep these repeaters up and operational. Please use them. The 440 repeater should be programmed as follows:
