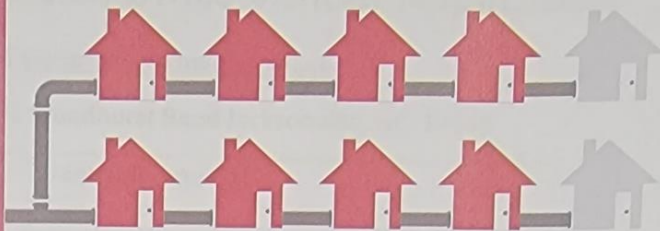

LEAD is a toxic heavy metal that can threaten your family's health every day. It can enter a person's body through their water supply.

Lead can get into a water supply through:



FAUCETS

GALVANIZED
STEEL PIPES

You can find out if you've been exposed to lead with a simple blood test. Even low levels of blood lead can cause:

- **Organ damage**
- **Delayed growth**
- **Lower IQ**
- **Behavioral disorders in children**
