Designed by renowned architect Richard Morris Hunt, Biltmore House has 250 rooms, 65 fireplaces, 43 bathrooms, 3 kitchens and is filled with the immense collection of art and furnishings of its original owner, George Vanderbilt. The beauty of this grand home extends out-of-doors to its gardens. In all, Biltmore Estate encompasses 8,000 acres of land.
