



• DEDICATED TO OUR GUILD ON OUR MEETING NIGHTS

- Can stay on 2nd Monday of the month
- We will be the only ones at this facility on our meeting nights
- They guarantee not to schedule anything else those nights (no visitations, etc.)
- If any rooms are set up, all doors will be closed
- Washrooms on same level
- Fully accessible

BENEFITS OF THIS FACILITY

- Same price as current fee at church
- Parking lot large and well lit
- Large washrooms, on same level
- Fully accessible
- On major public transport route
- Decorated multipurpose event space
- Facility is providing tea, coffee, milk/cream, sugar, dishes at no extra charge
- Setup of room and takedown after will be done for us, included in price
- Audio, TV/screen, zoom and internet (no extra cost)
- Will store our library books and move them in and out for us
- Large fits current membership with room to expand

BENEFITS OF THIS FACILITY

- No extra insurance cost
- Catering available
- Can move to a bigger room if needed
- Has a quilt display stand we can use
- No need for a full year contract savings for the 3 winter virtual months
- No sales pitch info on the funeral home will NOT be given at our nights
- Someone from the event space is there don't have to open or lock up
- Can't find as good a place for such a low cost
- Might be able to give up storage locker since no longer need library storage

CURRENT CHURCH LOCATION

- Cost is going up in January
 - On top of 50% increase in rent for 2022
 - It is going up again for 2023 (amount unknown)
- New EXTRA insurance required (would cost an additional \$270 for 2023)
- Set up is no longer done for us
- Would need full contract (including the 3 months we will be virtual)
- Dark parking lot, not sufficient space
- No real public transit options
- No real possibility to do a zoom hybrid
 - Have to pay for church media person to do it extra \$100+ per month and no guarantee anyone would be available
