






- *James Furher* recorded an albatross on the fourth hole at St. Mary Golf and Country Club (Berwick, La.) on Feb. 25. Furher's second shot on the par-5 found the cup from 235 yards.
- Louis Voorhies joined the Albatross Club at BREC's Santa Maria Golf Course (Baton Rouge, La.) on Jan. 5. The second shot on the par-5 seventh hole was from 171 yards out with a 4-iron.



- *Christopher Randel* joined the Albatross Club at Southern Trace Country Club (Shreveport, La.) on Jan. 16. The second shot on the par-5 first hole (510 yards) was from 265 yards out with a 3-wood.
- Cody Maxwell registered an albatross at Greystone Golf and Country Club (Denham Springs, La.) on March 27. Maxwell, who lives in Denham Springs and is the Assistant Golf Professional at Greystone, recorded a two on the par-5 fourth. His tee shot went 270 yards and his next shot was with a 4-wood from 235 yards out.

### MGT STARTS WITH 6 **FOUNDING MEMBERS**

Every golf trail in America had to start somewhere and the Mississippi Golf Trail made its start earlier this year with six founding courses.

Starting at the top of the state is Timber Truss Golf Course in Olive Branch. Then in the northeast lackson Metro area is Bay Pointe Golf and Country Club in Brandon. The most western course on the MGT is Natchez Golf Club at Duncan Park in historic Natchez To the east of Natchez is Okatoma Golf Club in Collins and then a little bit south is Pine Creek Golf Club in Purvis. The Mississippi Golf Trail is anchored on the Coast by Shell Landing Golf Club in Gautier.

Collectively, these courses have been entertaining golfers for 271 years. That's a lot of golf! Natchez Golf Club is the oldest as it

opened with nine holes back in 1916. In the early 1990s, the facility increased to 18 holes. The newest course on the MGT is Shell Landing, which opened in 2000. All six courses are unique.

Shell Landing Golf Club, designed by Davis Love III, is a must-play on the Gulf Coast as the course has gotten many accolades from the national publications. The course can play as long as 7,024 yards from the back tees and as



short as 5,047 yards from the women's tees. There are three other course lengths for all types of players, who will also enjoy the impressive practice facilities. This championship course features diverse topography and natural beauty of the waterfront location. It features a three-hole string of fun par-4s on holes 4-6 On the back nine, the two par-3 holes (Nos. 11 and 17) are the most aesthetically pleasing holes you will find.

Pine Creek Golf Club is a hidden gem just east of I-59. The course is popular to locals and hosts a bunch of tournaments. Pine Creek Golf Club sits on an impressive piece of property in the state's Pinebelt. This facility has the unique distinction of draining right into Beaver Lake, which not only provides water for the course, but also is a beautiful backdrop for the driving range. Pine Creek's draining is so good, the course is rarely cart-path only even after a heavy rain.


Okatoma Golf Club is an enjoyable course 30 miles northwest of Hattiesburg. The fun and very playable course features open fairways, native forest, natural rolling terrain and impressive greens. The facility gets its name from the



nearby Okatoma Creek, which was named by the Choctaw Tribe. This course, which features some beautiful scenery, is popular for tournament play and has great customer service, which is a staple of all Mississippi Golf Trail courses. It is something the Magnolia State is known for and a big reason players keep coming back.

Located just a few miles from Historic Downtown Natchez is **Natchez Golf Club**. The facility is located alongside Duncan Park and has welcomed all-time greats like Walter Hagen, Sam Snead and Babe Zaharias over the last 105 years of being in business. This course features rolling terrain, dogwoods, long-leaf pine trees and towering oaks draped in Spanish Moss. In the spring, beautiful azaleas come to life all over the course. The course isn't as long as modern courses, but that doesn't make it any easier as this tract has survived the test of time and still remains a championship layout. The popular Natchez Open is played here annually attracting the area's top amateurs and professionals.

**Bay Pointe Golf and Country Club** sits 13 miles northeast of the Jackson International Airport and on the southeast tip of the massive Ross Barnett Reservoir. Bay Pointe is semi-private (has members and





The Belton Family has owned the facility since 1992. The course has a mix of hilly areas and some water features. It is a very popular place for tournaments.

Holding down the northern tip of the Mississippi Golf Trail is *Timber Truss Golf Course*, which is only 14 miles from the Memphis International Airport. The facility used to be Plantation Golf Club, but with new ownership came a new name, improved conditions and major upgrades to the clubhouse. The logo and name comes from the signature bridge behind the 13th green. Timber Truss is an impressive tract that



draws great reviews its customers. The clubhouse now features a simulator and there are also new carts with the latest GPS technology.

Also available for those that want to experience something different on the course, Timber Truss has the Finn Cycle, which is a solo rider motorcycle-looking golf cart. The course itself is known for its above-average course conditions and great overall experience. Timber Truss Golf Course is a must-play anytime you are in North Mississippi.
