

A GREAT PAIR OF LOUISIANA RESORTS



Looking to get away to one of Louisiana's great resorts?
That's a great idea as Coushatta Casino Resort and
Paragon Casino Resort are two of the state's best!

Coushatta Casino Resort is located in Kinder, which is located 38 miles northeast of Lake Charles.

Paragon Casino Resort is located in Marksville, which is located 32 miles southeast of Alexandria.

Coushatta is home to Koasati Pines Golf Course. Paragon is home to Tamahka Trails Golf Club.

Both courses are highly rated and part of the state's Audubon Golf Trail. When opened in 2002, Koasati Pines was the state's longest course at 7,617 yards from the back (black) tees. It is still the longest resort course in Louisiana. Tamahka Trails Golf Club checks in at 7,019 yards from its back tees (also black). Both courses also have ample tees for all types of players. Another thing the resorts have in common are a slew of amenities that cater to all.

In regards to the courses, Tamahka Trails Golf Club — opened in 2000 — has recently underwent a renovation and it is up for the Golf Digest Best Renovation of the Year Award. Koasati Pines has been consistently on Golf Advisor and Golf Digest's best-of lists in Louisiana and the South. Nestled in the natural wetlands, Koasati Pines features stately pines and huge live oaks. Three holes have multiple approaches and the layout features 65 acres of lakes. If you need an extra challenge, the 19th Gambling Hole is an island green that can be used to settle any friendly bets.
