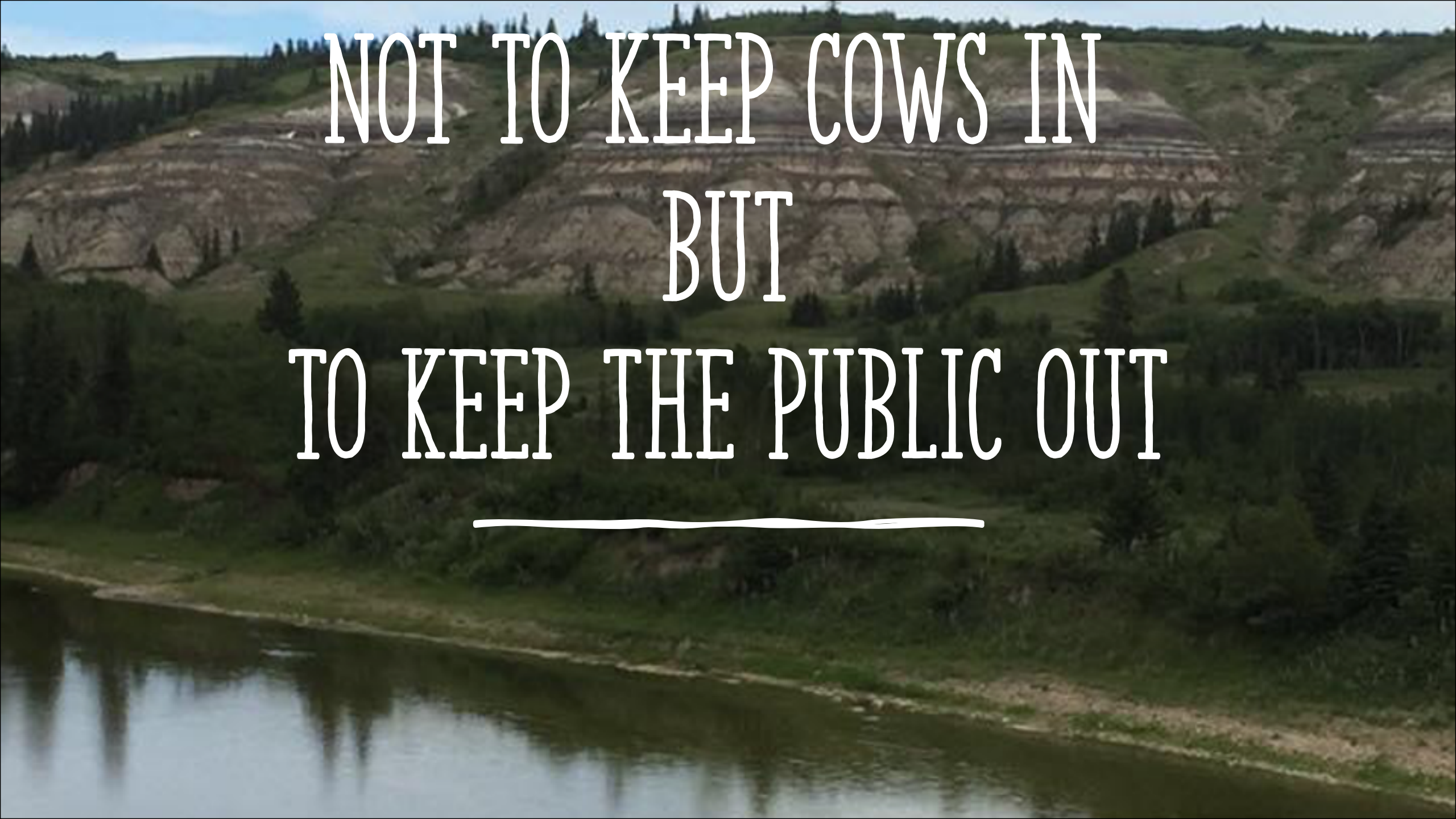




IN 2017, THE LEASEHOLDER

INTO THE RIVER VALLEY

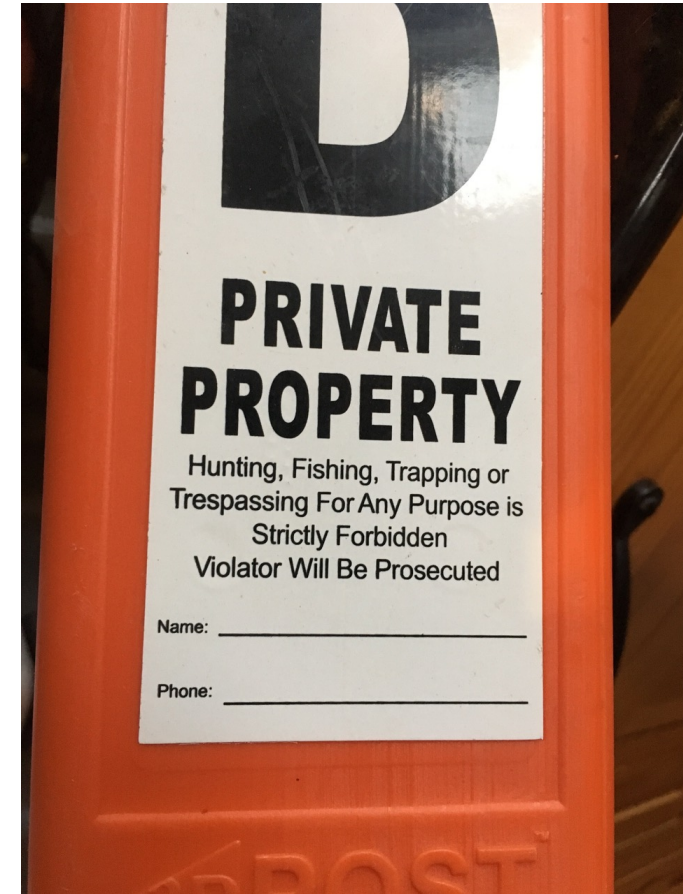
A FENCE WAS ERECTED

THE LIMITED VEGETATION OF THE BADLANDS, LAID TO WASTE



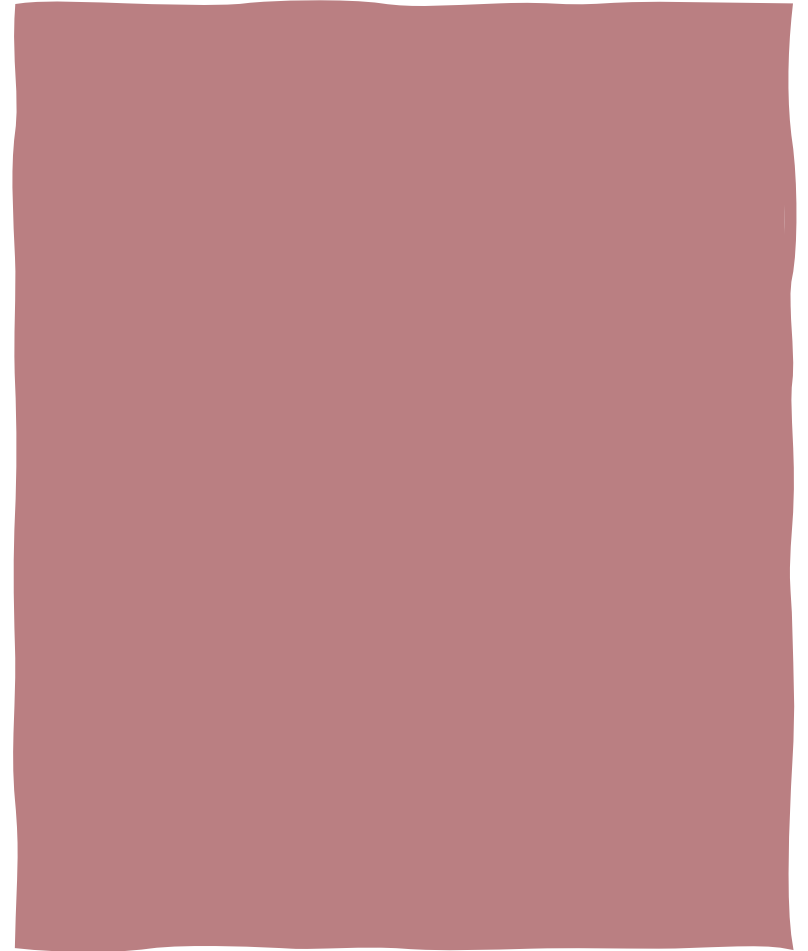

FROM ACCESSING THE PUBLIC LAND

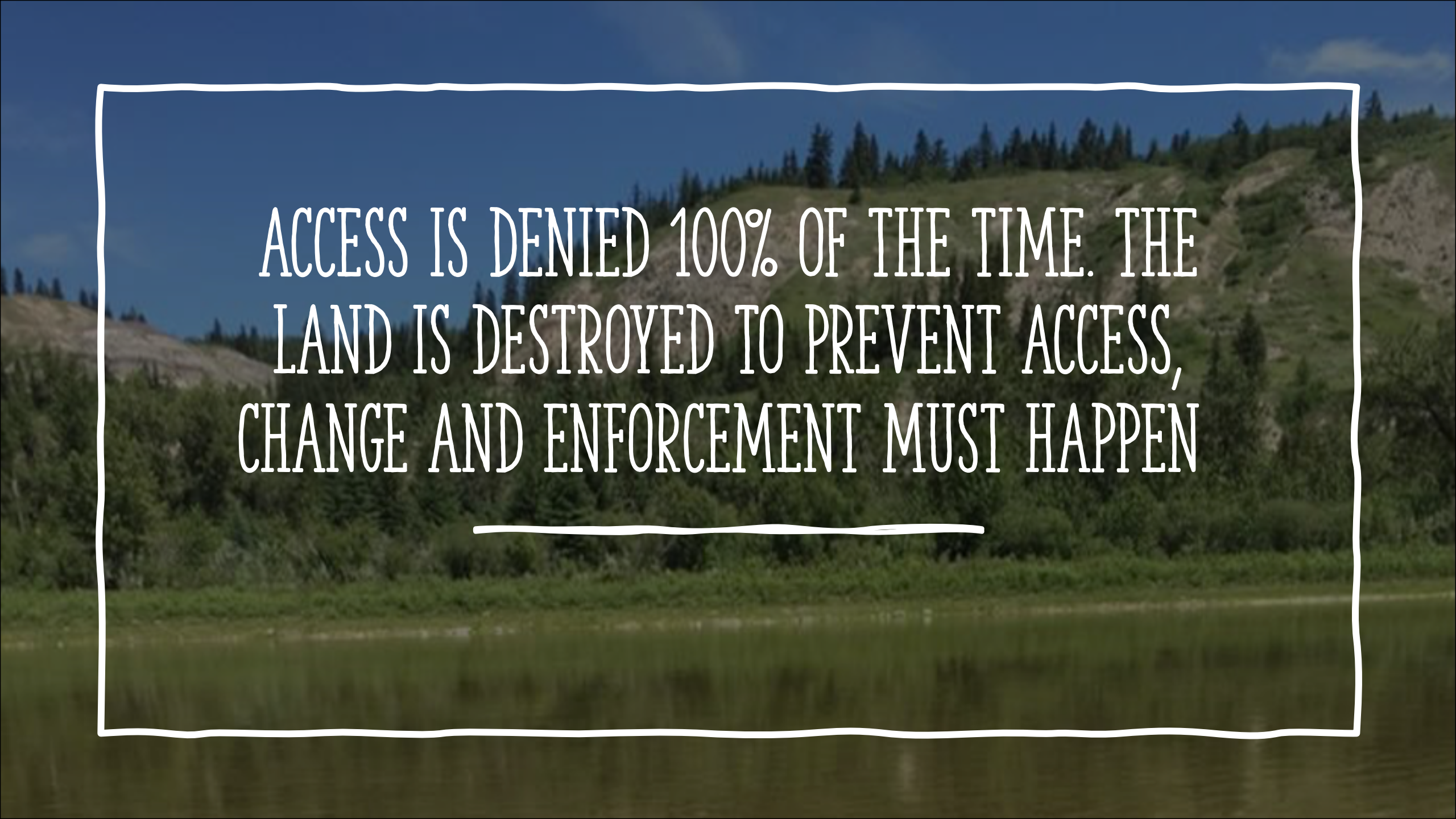


THE GRAZING LEASE STEWARDSHIP CODE OF CONDUCT STATES:

- THE LEASEHOLDER IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC BENEFITS TO ALLOW ALBERTANS TO ENJOY BEAUTIFUL LANDSCAPES, WATERSHEDS, MAINTAIN BIODIVERSITY AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR REASONS LIKE HUNTING AND TOURISM.

THE GRAZING LEASE STEWARDSHIP CODE OF CONDUCT STATES:

- LEASEHOLDERS ARE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATION, WHICH IS TO BALANCE THE RIGHT OF RECREATIONAL USERS TO ACCESS WITH THE LEASEHOLDERS RIGHT TO PROTECT THE LAND, LIVESTOCK AND IMPROVEMENTS.



ACCESS IS DENIED 100% OF THE TIME. THE
LAND IS DESTROYED TO PREVENT ACCESS,
CHANGE AND ENFORCEMENT MUST HAPPEN
